**Jeff Porasik Wells Fargo Advisors Endurance Series Race.** Open to all closed wheel cars under 3000cc. Limit is 50 cars. You must preregister for this race no later than Friday Aug 14, 1pm. PLEASE BE VERY CONSCIOUS OF THE POTENTIAL FOR LARGE SPEED DIFFERENTIALS IN THIS RACE.

#### Thursday August 18th

- 6:00 PM - 9:00 PM Registration opens. No one will be admitted to the track prior to registering.
- Balloting for the Badgers VS Spartans/Wolverines Challenge begins
- Due to the Track being rented / occupied on Thursday, no one will be allowed into the Paddock area until 6:00 PM.
- Tech Inspection is open 6:30 PM to 8:00 PM.

We will be accepting annual techs from any VMC recognized club, but reserve the right to inspect any car at random, at the chief of tech's discretion. You must register before gaining access to the paddock and technical inspection. After registration, but prior to access to the paddock, our Chief of Tech, Dave Young, will process entrants with Annual Techs prior to paddock availability, at the picnic table located just before the track cross over. PLEASE, do not block the road running from the Registration building to the crossover. Technical Inspection will be moved to the Tech Building in the upper paved Paddock after paddock entry is allowed.

#### Friday August 19th

Pool hours-9am to 8pm - NO GUARDS ON DUTY - SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK-CHILDREN UNDER 16 YEARS OLD MUST BE SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT OVER 21 YEARS OLD.

Track crossovers are permitted between sessions but vary in length depending on clean up time required by track workers - BE PREPARED TO CROSS OVER IMMEDIATELY AT THE CLOSE OF A SESSION!

•**All times are approximate!** Listen for your group to be announced!! Watch for when the group preceding yours starts.

•**All laps listed per session are approximate!** Subject to change by the Chief Steward and Event Chair based on racing conditions.

- Please report to the grid lane 10 minutes before the start of your session. Grid lane begins immediately behind the Starter Stand and connects to the race track at Turn 3.
- All Warm Up, Practice & Qualifying races start single file from the grid lane without a pace car.
- First lap of Practice Sessions on Friday will show white flags at the stations so that drivers can see which stations are manned.
- Qualifying Sessions will go out green.
- All races will go out under full-course (double) yellow. Course will go "green" at start finish line.
