WHAT ARE "CUP RACES"?

The Kimberly, Sheldon, and Elkhart Lake Cup races began in the early days when the racing was done on the public roads around Elkhart Lake.

The Kimberly Cup is named after Jim Kimberly; an early pioneer in SCCA racing. Kimberly Cup is for closed wheel cars with lap times of 3 minutes or over.

The Sheldon Cup is named after C Bayard Sheldon who was an early promoter/founder of the races. The Sheldon Cup is for closed wheel cars with lap times under 3 minutes.

The Elkhart Lake Cup was an open wheel race with no size limit. Elkhart Lake Cup is for cars in Groups 4, 5, 7, and 10.

The Carl Haas Cup joins us this year. Carl Haas contributed a lifetime to road racing and was the importer of Lola race cars to the USA.

The Carl Haas Cup is for cars in Groups 5 & 7.
