### WHAT ARE "CUP RACES"?

The Kimberly, Sheldon, and Elkhart Lake Cup races began in the early days when the racing was done on the public roads around Elkhart Lake. The Kimberly Cup is named after Jim Kimberly; an early pioneer in SCCA racing. **Kimberly Cup is for cars in Groups 1,2, and 3.**

The Sheldon Cup is named after C Bayard Sheldon who was an early promoter/founder of the races. **Sheldon Cup is for cars in Groups 6,8, and 9.**

The Elkhart Lake Cup was an open wheel race with no size limit. **Elkhart Lake Cup is for cars in Group 4,7,10 and Group 5**

### What are the Cup Races today?

They're free races for all production-based cars. You fit into a particular "Cup Race" based on your group. This ensures close racing.
