In vintage racing, you win by having a safe, sane, fun competitive race with someone and then sharing the experience with them at the end of the day over a beer. Every racer appreciates smooth and consistent driving and it inspires everyone to a better performance.

If you are:

-surprising other drivers by "showing up" unexpectedly,
-chopping their lines, blocking, dive bombing,
-using slower cars as rolling chicanes,
-ignoring flags-especially yellow flags,
-and are generally scaring the hell out of your fellow competitors,

you are doing something very wrong!

Everybody will notice you—for all the **wrong** reasons - don't be that guy!"
