Join the competitors from across the globe as VSCDA celebrates 36 years of racing at Road America. VSCDA is proud to introduce an entire weekend celebrating Women In Motorsports for the first time in vintage history. This weekend is sure to please car enthusiasts of all ages, focusing on our women's history in motorsports. We will begin our celebration Friday night at the Road America Center with a social gathering (light meal) and the opportunity to meet and greet our honored women guests. Saturday aims to please with a women's feature race followed by a wine reception for all the ladies at the track. The banquet at the Road America Tufte Center will allow everyone to enjoy the many personal stories shared by all prominent women of motorsports.

Registration & Tech opens at 2 pm on Thursday. Friday is a practice, with each group getting almost 2 hours of track time. That should give you ample seat time to get reacquainted with the longest and fastest road course in North America. The traditional enduro benefiting Disabled American Veterans will be held Friday afternoon. This race always has an entire grid of diverse cars. As a unique feature, ride along with one of the women in motorsport during our lunchtime touring on Saturday and Sunday. Proceeds will go to the driver's favorite charity.

Once again, we will have our customer-friendly express Tech for those drivers who have an annual VSCDA Tech.

The Cup races will continue and will now accommodate the open-wheel groups. These races have become very popular, and 2022 will be the 13th year for the "Cup" races. Kimberly, Sheldon, and Elkhart Lake Cup races are based on the original "Cup" races held from 1950-to 1952 on the roads around Elkhart Lake. This allows drivers to race against cars they usually do not. It also guarantees close racing.

Saturday, we have qualifying sessions and sprint races. If your schedule permits, you may want to participate in the original Road Course Re-enactment. This will be the police escorted tour of the original public road racecourse for race and streetcars. These roads are listed as a national historical monuments. Along with Watkins Glen, these are the only two sets of roads listed as such. VSCDA has been doing the re-enactment tour for thirty years, and it can attract up to one hundred cars. The tour will finish at Road America and be parked around to enjoy our Concourse d' Elegance this year. The participants and the spectators thoroughly enjoy this event.

A newly added event for your pleasure is Canvas and Coffee on Saturday morning (10:00 am) for anyone who needs a break from seat time or a break from the pits. It will be an excellent time hosted by our own Chris Bonk's Bottles and Bottega. You must preregister for this event. \$35.00 add to registration or see us in registration at the track. Our Saturday evening banquet will be held at The Tufte Center, a banquet hall under the Paddock Shop. The evening will feature Women in motorsports.
