

VSCDA kicks off its 2019 Race Season with its Driver's School followed by a weekend of racing at GingerMan Raceway in South Haven, Michigan. GingerMan is a safe, 2.2 mile challenge, designed by Alan Wilson and with a growing national reputation. It rewards excellent technical driving skill with two long straights and lots of complex turns, incorporating camber and elevation changes.

The weekend starts with VSCDA's highly-regarded Driver's School on Thursday afternoon, May 2nd, with a required classroom session. May 3rd is an all day on-track school-very busy, very exciting and very fun! We try to have a 1 to 1 ratio of experienced racer/instructors for each student. That evening, driving privileges are awarded and accomplishments celebrated at a great barbecue. Upon graduation, you gain racing privileges recognized by VSCDA, as well as most other vintage groups in the VMC Organizations (3 race with an "X" on your car, incident free required).

Our race weekend begins on Saturday May 5th. Our regular racers and school graduates enjoy two days on the track with plenty of seat time. Qualifying races are on Saturday with feature races on Sunday. Sharing a delicious barbecue Saturday evening with your fellow racers will top a great day.
